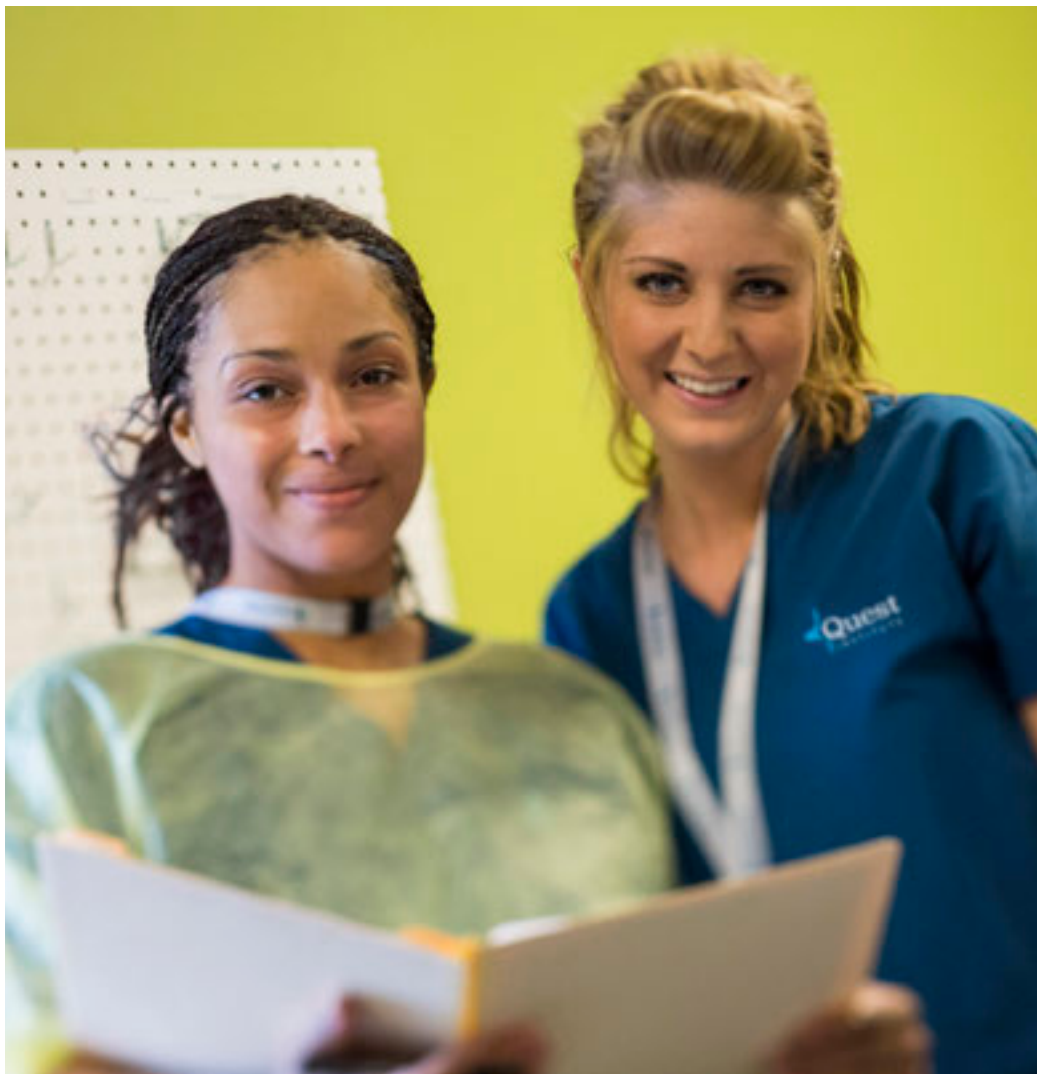
Basic Life Support certifications, preparing them for possible careers including: Certified Nurse Aide, Home Health Aide and Direct Care Workers.

CNA students will learn:

- Assisting residents in attaining and maintaining functional independence
- Basic nursing skills
- Personal care skills
- Supporting and promoting patients' rights
- Demonstrating skills needed in assessing health and well-being

Students will attend classes at the Jackson campus (209 E. Washington Ave. Suite 241), with clinical externships taking place at healthcare facilities in the community. The 84-hour program will offer three semester credits.
