

Student Right-to-Know Act

According to regulations published by the Department of Education based on the Student Right-to-Know Act, the Student Right-to-Know (SRTK) Graduate Rate is described as follows:

It is based upon students who entered as full-time first-time students and graduated within 150 percent of the length of their program. For example: regarding a certificate/diploma student, whose program is typically approximately eight months, this 150 percent measure describe students graduating from an eight-month program within 12 months.
