Hello **Student Name**,

You recently applied for an Emergency Financial Aid Grant via the CARES Act and the U.S. Department of Education. These grants were made available to students of our Institution who need financial support for their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the Coronavirus pandemic. These funds permit students to use these need-based grants for Coronavirus related expenses that you have incurred or will incur in completing your education such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care and child-care. **CONGRATULATIONS!** Based on what you recently provided on the student attestation application, Career Quest's Campus Administration has determined that you qualify for grant monies. Your initial payment will be sent to your mailing address via the United States Postal Service (USPS) this week. Subsequent payments, if any, may be more or less than this initial amount based available funding and your student status. As a reminder, only active students who are in good standing, Title IV eligible and making Satisfactory Academic Progress will be able to receive grant dollars. Now that your grant eligibility has been determined, Career Quest's Campus Administration will issue additional grant checks at the next payment cycle which will be week 4 of each campus module to active and eligible students until all of the grant funds have been exhausted
